

**About Genesee Valley Plein Air Painters:** Organized in September 2005, Genesee Valley Plein Air Painters, Inc. is a fully-insured artist association that promotes and inspires quality plein air painting while providing socially pleasant painting opportunities for its membership throughout the year. Our artist members meet to paint outside throughout the year. Painting subjects include landscapes, cityscapes and waterscapes from Buffalo to the Finger Lakes to Central New York State and the 1000 Islands region. Plein air is French and means “open air.” All pieces in this show have been painted outside, in natural light, at the site of the subject. The paintings in this exhibition represent works that have been produced within the past two years. They meet the definition of “plein air” as set by this association (at least 85% of painting completed on-site), produced in a painting medium (oil, water media, pastel, cold wax).
