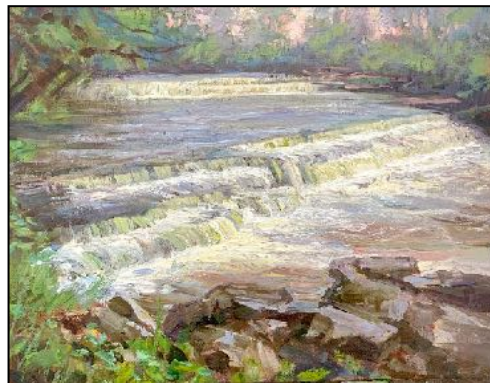

With Chris Kolupski

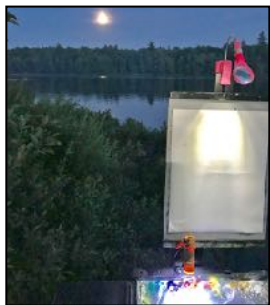

WAX ON; WAX OFF

We just spent a beautiful summer's day at Phyllis Bryce Ely and Maureen Outlaw Church's Encaustic and Cold wax Workshop held at Phyllis' house on Ontario Lake. Ten artists participated. First Maureen demonstrated using cold wax as a medium with oil paint and showed us all the ways we could use it and why.

Then, Phyllis showed us how to use hot wax with both pastel and with oil paint to create beautiful effects.

After the demonstrations, they invited us to make art using all the new techniques, mediums and equipment they had just shown us. They had several work stations set up and we could move from station to station at our own pace experimenting with the materials and implementing the new techniques we had just learned.. Phyllis and Maureen moved amongst us helping us with the equipment (including a blow torch that I had never used before) if needed.

A continental breakfast was provided for those who had missed breakfast. All in all it was a thoroughly enjoyable day being with friends and making art.

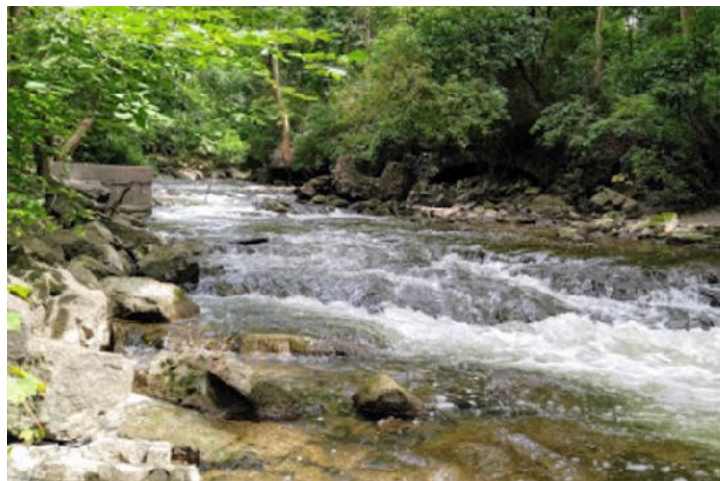
